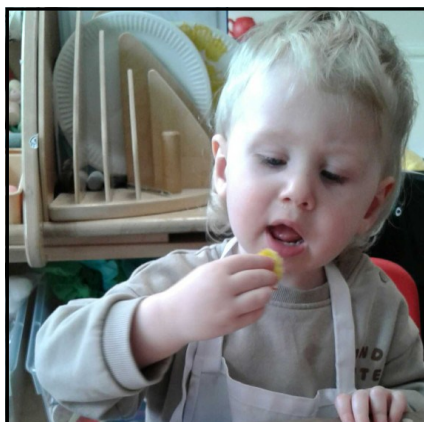
Easter Extravaganza

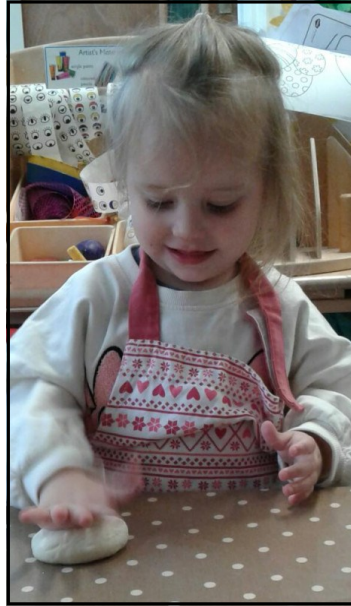
Squirrel Special Day: Picnic Lunch at the Park

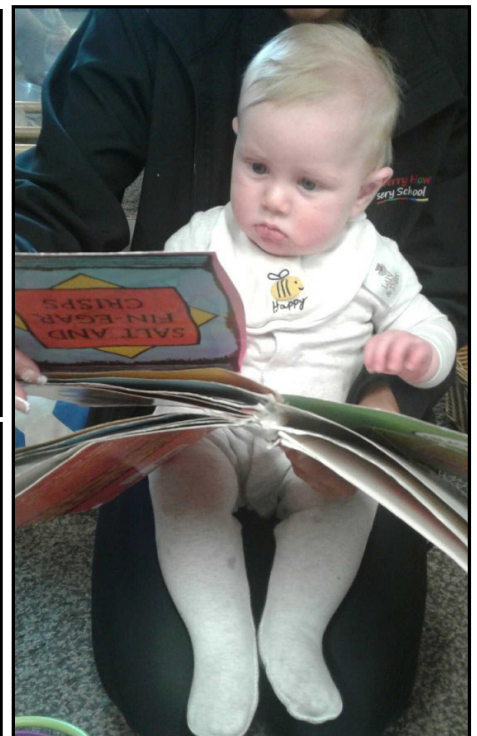
Butterflies Animal Week
