

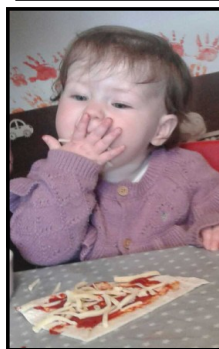


# Strawberry How Nursery School

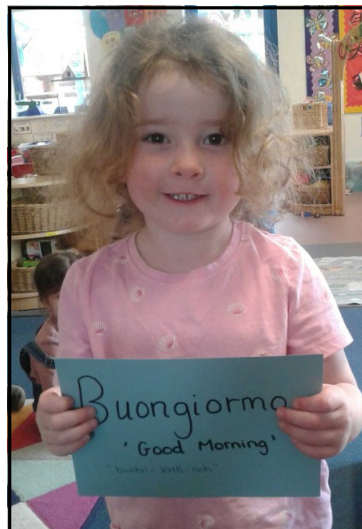

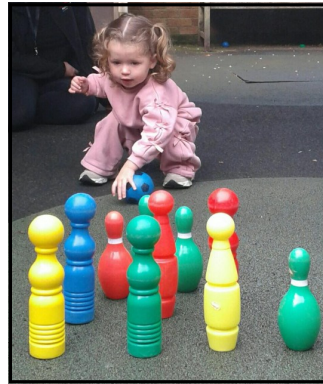
# Around the World—Tour of Europe
